



## The Arc of Chester County Title VI Public Notice

The Arc of Chester County gives notice that it complies with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Americans with Disabilities Act. Admissions, the provisions of services, and referrals of participants shall be made without regard to race, color, national origin, religion, age, ancestry, sex including gender identity and sexual orientation, or disability. Program services shall be made accessible to eligible persons with disabilities through the most practical and economically feasible methods available.

Any individual (and/or their parent, guardian, or surrogate) who believes that he or she has been discriminated against may file a complaint with The Arc of Chester County.
